**梅家坞茶文化村 Meijiawu Tea Culture Village** enjoys the same reputation as Longjing Village and Shifeng Village. In the village, there are 2,380 mu tea plantations (1 mu is roughly equal to 666 square meters), over 160 tea houses, and many landscape resources including Former Premier Zhou Enlai Memorial Hall, Shi Li Lang Dang (十里琅玕) and Historical Relics of Emperor Qianlong, forming a tea culture environment integrating tea picking, tea making, tea appreciation and leisure.

**Visit Meijiawu.** Along the Meiling Road on both sides of the depth of more than ten miles, known as "ten miles of Meiwu". Meijiawu is an ancient tea culture village with a history of more than 600 years. With mountains and beauty, docks and water, tea and culture, Meijiawu Tea Culture Village is one of the first-class conservation area and main production area of Longjing tea in West Lake, and is also the richest tea village and tea culture leisure tourism area in the suburbs of Hangzhou.

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**Lingyin Temple (灵隐寺)** , also known as Yunlin Temple, is located in the northwest of the West Lake in Hangzhou City, Zhejiang Province. It is one of the ten most famous ancient Buddhist temples in China, and has a history of more than 1600 years. The temple was first built by an Indian monk Huili in 326AD during the Eastern Jin dynasty. Lingyin Temple is a scenic resort and a famous ancient temple in the south of the Yangtze River.

The Imperial Stele Pavilion is located in front of the Hall of the Heavenly Kings at the eastern side of the temple. It possesses a stone tablet that has autographical inscriptions written by the Emperor Kangxi and Emperor Qianlong in the Qing Dynasty.

The Liandeng Pavilion is situated to the east of the Dining Hall, which is especially

responsible for receiving visitors. Visitors shall be guided to Liandeng Pavilion by the receptionist or the assistant receptionist for further communication.

The Hall of Heavenly Kings is the first hall after entering the temple. A tablet inscribed with “cloud forest Buddhist temple” , penned by Emperor Kangxi, who was inspired on one occasion by the sight of the temple in the mist and trees, was hung above the door, producing a sacred atmosphere here.

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**Qiandao Lake(千岛湖)** It is located in Chun'an County, Zhejiang Province, China, is a man-made reservoir formed after the completion of the Xin'an River hydroelectric station in 1959. The lake is renowned for its clear, drinkable water, which is used to

produce the Nongfu Spring brand of mineral water. Qiandao Lake is home to over 1,000 islands, including 1,078 large islands and thousands of smaller ones, covering an area of 573 square kilometers and with a storage capacity of 17.8 billion cubic meters. The lake is surrounded by verdant mountains and dotted with luxuriant vegetation, making it a popular tourist attraction. Qiandao Lake National Forest Park, which covers 448 square kilometers, has a forest coverage rate of 81% and is a designated national first-class water area. The lake is also known for its diverse wildlife and resources, including 1,786 plant species, 87 kinds of freshwater fish, and a variety of fruits and agricultural products.
